Being Julian's Voice

Julian, in Belmarsh Prison, has no way of defending himself.

He has no internet, no laptop, & restricted access to his lawyers.

He needs our support. We must act to get our government to intervene to stop US extradition of Julian.

Why Stop His Extradition?

Two main reasons:

1. We stand up for our nation's stars! Whether they are sports persons or intellects.

Julian is a star – an Australian intellect, born in Townsville, educated at Central Queensland University and the University of Melbourne. He has won the highest awards for his journalism and has been nominated 7 times for the Nobel Peace Prize.

2. 17 indictments under the US Espionage Act means Julian faces 170 years in a US Supermax prison, which Bob Carr (former Minister for Foreign Affairs) described as a death sentence. If successful, this means US law is global.

2. Inform



If the US are successful, Julian will be tortured and incarcerated for the rest of his life. This sets a new precedent for free press.
